


6 Step 6: Click on the "Enroll" button as indicated in the screenshot.






Step 9: Once you have accessed the course, proceed through the entire content. When you are ready to move forward, click the "Continue" button. On the left side you can track your progress throughout the course.






Step 11: Select the "Leave lesson" option from the available choices. This action will allow you to exit the course.




Step 12: When you are ready to continue your course, Click on the "Start" button as indicated in the screenshot. 12





Step 13: You can see in the top left corner that your course progress has not been lost.










Step 17: Please answer all the questions. You must obtain a 70% grade to pass the exam.
